



PGI Fishing Club 2010 Master Anglers Tournament Rules

Who

- Limited to members of the PGI Fishing Club.

General Rules

- Eligible species are
 1. Cobia
 2. Grouper
 3. King Mackerel
 4. Redfish
 5. Sea Trout
 6. Snook
 7. Spanish Mackerel
- Fish caught out of season are eligible for prizes, but must be returned to the water after a photo is taken.
- All entries must be caught in local waters (within a 50 mile radius of PGI).
- **Paid "Charter Captains" may not be used within the Charlotte Harbor area, however may be used for offshore fishing ventures.**
- Winning entries will be based on length, measured from the nose to the end of the pinched tail, except Cobia, King Mackerel and Spanish Mackerel, which are to be measured from the nose to the fork of the tail.
- The length of an eligible fish shall be calculated to the closest ½ inch, rounded down to the closest inch or ½ inch. Example – a 30¾ inch fish will be rounded down to 30 inches, a 30¾ inch will be rounded down to 30½ inches.
- Your PGIFC encourages CPR (catch, photograph, and release).

When

- Master Angler Tournament will run from January 1st, 2010, through November 30th, 2010.

Prizes

- There will be three winners in each category.
 1. First place for the longest fish.
 2. Second place for the second longest fish.
 3. Third place for the third longest fish.
- Club members can only win one award per species.
- Winner's prize certificates will be presented at the December, 2010 Holiday Dinner Party. Updates will be given at the monthly meetings and current standings will be listed in your newsletter.

Recording/Reporting Fish

- A photograph of the fish with your name, fish species, length, and date caught, noted on the back of the photo, or in the body of your email, will be your entry form, (honor system must prevail).
- All entries must be turned in **within three weeks** of the date the fish is caught. Any entry received **after three weeks** from the date of catch will not be eligible.
- Entries for fish caught the last week of the contest must be received by November 30th
- The photo is now your entry form for all club fishing events, the Master Angler Tournament, the Ladder of Achievement Program and the Fish of the Month Contest.
- Eligibility for each program will be determined by the Club's appointed scorekeeper.
- All entries should be emailed to the Fishing Events Director at PGIFishingClub@pgica.org, or drop it off at the PGICA facility and placed in the fishing clubs folder, or handed in at one

of the monthly club meetings.
